- Assignment, Attachment and Location. The 501st Administration Company was redesignated as the 501st Adjutant General Company effective 1 March 1971. The AG Company was transferred to CINCUSAREUR effective 5 May 1971.
- Mission: Provides complete Postal Services (Mail Distribution and Dispatch, Money Orders, Stamps, Insured, Registry and Unit Mailroom Inspection Services) and Division mail directory service for all personnel and elements assigned to the Division.
