1. ASSIGNMENT, ATTACHMENT AND LOCATION.

The 139th AG Company (Postal) is assigned to US Army Postal Group, Europe, APO 09081 (Schwetzingen, Germany) and attached to VII Corps, APO 09107 (Moehringen, Germany) for administrative and logistical support per Headquarters, US Army Europe and Seventh Army General Order 1779 dated 5 Mar 76 with effective date of 55 Mar 76. The 139th AG Co (Postal) was further attached to the US Military Community Activity, Stuttgart per Headquarters, VII Corps General Order 43 dated 18 Mar 74, with an effective date of 31 Dec 73. The unit headquarters is located at Mallace Barracks, Stuttgart, Germany.

2. MISSION.

The mission of the 139th AG Co (Postal) is to provide mail movement and complete postal service (Mail distribution and dispatch, money orders, postage stamp, and accountable mail services) and perform APO directory service for authorized individuals, organizations and activities in the Goeppingen, Heilbronn, Ludwigsburg/Kornwestheim, Schwaebisch Gmuend, Schwaebisch Hall, Stuttgart, and Zuffenhausen/Bad Cannstatt area.

ORGANIZATION.

The 139th AG Co (Postal) UIC D2AAAA was reorganized under MTDE 12-550HE106 per Headquarters, US Army Europe and Seventh, Army General Order 193 dated 8 Jan 76 with an effective date of 21 Jun 76. Unit strength is 4 officers and 78 enlisted. Unit is organized into 16 cellular teams consisting of one Headquarters team, six Mail Processing teams, and ten Postal Finance teams.

- 9. POSTAL SUPPORT TO EXCERCISES & OPERATIONS.

a. The 139th AG Co (Postal) provided support for exercise NINTEX PRIME TARGET 77 in the form of sending 1 officer and 2 NCO's to the FTX to monator message traffic, and postal operations in a war time environment.

b. The 139th AG Co (Postal) provided postal support to exercise REFORGER 77 during August, September and October 1977. Support consisted of providing receipt, processing and holding mail pending arrival of personnel and returning late arriving mail after exercise units returned to CONUS.

10. SUMMARY OF POSTAL OPERATIONS.

- a. The 139th AG Co (Postal) received direct Sealand Trailers of surface mail from New York with an average transit time of 25 days.
- b. The 139th AG Co (Postal) began receiving direct 20 foot air containers from New York on 20 Nov 76. These containers are sealed at JFK Airport and flown by Commercial airline to Frankfurt Air Terminal (FRAT), Frankfurt, Germany. From FRAT they are pulled by military tractor to APO 09154. Average transit time for air containers is 4 5 days.
- c. The 139th AG Co (Postal) began dispatching sealed 20 foot air containers to JFK Airport on 26 Nov 76. These containers are pulled by military tractor to Frankfurt Afr Terminal where they are loaded on airlines to be flown to JFK Airport. New York.
- d. The primary postal facilities operated by the 139th AG Co (Postal) are located at Robinson Barracks, Stuttgart (APO 09154); Mharton Barracks, Heilbronn (APO 09176); Dolan Barracks, Schwaebisch Hall (APO 09025); Schwaebisch Gmuend, Harte Kaserne (APO 09281). These postal units receive and dispatch all mail through APO 09154. All mail from APO 09164 is dispatched to APO 09082 (Offenbach) or APO 09097 (FRAT).

11. MAJOR UNITS AND HEADQUARTERS SERVED.

The 139th AG Co (Postal) provides postal support to the 5th Gen Hospital, US Military Community Activity Stuttgart, 128th Combat Support, 4th Transportation Bn and the 7th Engr Bde. Outlying unit support includes military communities in Schwaebisch Hall, Schwaebisch Gnuend, Goeppingen and Heilbronn, Also 1st Inf Div (FMD), 14 Avm GP.
